Day of Dance 2010 Programme

9.30 onwards	<p>Arrive and park at Old Rectory (near the village school). Members of Minster Strays will be on hand to show you where to park.</p> <p>Tea/coffee and biscuits and information at the village hall.</p>
10.00	<p>Meet the teams - outside the pub.</p> <p>A chance for the Minster Strays, and the village, to meet the visiting sides and see each other dance.</p>
10.30 – 10.45	<p>Everyone boards the coach for Beningbrough Hall from entrance to Rectory driveway, adjacent to village school.</p>
11.30	<p>Arrive at Beningbrough Hall.</p>
11.45 – 12.30	<p>1st dance spot – see programme of dance spots for your first location.</p>
12.30 – 1.30	<p>Collect picnic lunch from the Education Room and eat in Walled Garden [if fine]. Drinking water available in the Walled Garden; other drinks can be purchased from the café.</p>
1.30 – 2.15	<p>2nd dance spot</p>
2.15 – 3.00	<p>3rd dance spot</p>
3.00 – 3.45	<p>4th dance spot</p>
4.00	<p>Mass dance and farewell to Beningbrough Hall.</p>
4.30	<p>Walk or have ride on coach to Blacksmith's Arms in Newton-on-Ouse [approx ten minutes' walk]. Instruments can be taken by bus.</p> <p>Informal dancing in pub garden/car park, in Cherry Tree Avenue or on the village green.</p>
6.00	<p>Depart from Newton-on-Ouse by coach</p>
6.45	<p>Arrive back at Thornton-le-Clay; you can bring your own drinks, or the pub next door will be open.</p>
7.30	<p>Buffet supper</p>
8.30 onwards	<p>Ceilidh and 'guest spots' from all you visitors!</p>
